A parent voiced concerns over the instructor for the second week. Admin took down the concerns along with the positives. Admin will reach out to Alien Inline and deal with feedback. Council agreed it would be a great thing to bring them back again for next year. *Fit Set Ninja will still run for the students on May 27 and 28 th . Apple Day and having parent volunteers. New Admin, Rosanne Boutin will be planning something in the future. This date did not line up for having an Apple Day. *Brandi put forth for the PAC to vote on a Teacher appreciation gift like we have done over the past years. Either a lunch for the teachers or gift cards. Average about \$20 per employee. There are 34 staff members currently so putting for a budget of \$700 which would have to come from the general account as the casino account does not allow for such purchases. |

Alberta School Councils/School Trustee Information:

- ASCA is pleased to confirm that the \$500.00 ASCE Grant provided by Alberta Education (page 105-106 of the Funding Manual for School Authorities) will be available to school councils once again for the 2024-2025 school year and can be used to pay for the majority of ASCA Learning Opportunities (whether virtual or in-person) and support services.

Meeting Dates for 2023/2024:

- June 4th

- *March 10th, 2025 a new certificate from the Government of Alberta was issues. It has been uploaded and saved on the SAC folder on Drive.
- *Next year the following Chairs will be open and up for voting at the 2025/26 School year, Parent Council AGM (to be determined at a later date); Chair is open, Secretary is open and Casino Chair is open. Courses MUST be taken through the Alberta School Council Association. Requirements for Parent Council rules and regulations for Executive Chairs. Also, must be able to attend ASCA Parent engagement nights planned through the school board.

It was discussed to use the ASCA \$500 grant money to help pay for Fit Set Ninja since we would be also having Apple Day. But now that Apple Day has been postponed, Rosanne has advised that because she has only taken over less than two weeks ago, she will be meeting with Teresa to discuss the **Students Summer Fun Day** that is held at the school every year. It was discussed having parent volunteers run the outdoor games and stations like last year. Rosanne will decide if the \$500 can be used to purchase hot dogs which can be served to the students and parent volunteers. The grant money has to be used to bring in more attention and participation to the parent council and has to be spent on parents. If it is not used for the Summer Fun Day for students, Roseanne will discuss with Teresa if there will be time to have a speaker come in and discuss how parent councils run and regulations. Going into next year prepared with a new council.

Next and last meeting for 2024/25 will be held on June 4th in person.

6.0 Woodvale Report

No report was provided by Woodvale. Brandi advised that the Big Bin Event is being held at the Hillview Baptist Church on May 24th and they are looking for people in the Woodvale area to volunteer. If someone from our school does volunteer on behalf of the school, if they could please let the school and Woodvale know that you are there on behalf of BJPI so we get credit towards the \$5,000 matching grant. The upcoming Bingos, dates and times are also on the website. The website lists who to contact if anyone wishes to work the bingos for Woodvale Community league. Again, if anyone works a bingo on behalf of BJPI, please let Woodvale and the school know so it can go towards the 10 volunteers we need a year to obtain the entire \$5,000.00

Brandi will reach out to Woodvale to find out about the \$1,500 we have in volunteer credits/grant monies and ask if it can be used towards furniture that was purchased for the classrooms that was denied by AGLC to use casino funds for.

7.0 Principal Report

Faith & Community Life

- We began April with Holy Week reflections in our classrooms, and our students participated in a beautiful Stations of the Cross liturgy with parish staff weekly.
- We will have our Easter Liturgy on Wednesday, April 23 with Father Ben.
- We had a spring assembly on Wednesday, April 16
- School will be closed on April 18 and 21 for Good Friday and Easter Monday. We wish all families a blessed Easter season.
- Spring Jazz Concert for Class 3/4C, Grades
 4, 5, and 6 students at 6:30pm on April 30.
 Eventbrite will be used for tickets.
- Drama Production starring Hamlet and Little Prince on May 1 at 6:00pm. Eventbrite will be used for tickets.
- Federal Election we are not a voting site on April 28.

Student Learning & Activities

- Teachers continue to focus on literacy and numeracy goals. We've implemented targeted interventions in reading groups and are seeing encouraging progress. Reading groups will start to come to a close at the end of April to make way for assessments. Support will continue when assessments are complete.
- Spanish Bilingual Programming and FSL in Grades 4, 5, 6 next school year: We are looking to increase our minutes in Spanish Literacy next year to support deepening of language learning. There will be no disadvantage to students who wish to take FSL in Grade 7 as students can enter into the FSL pathway at any grade.
- Spanish Bilingual Parent Engagement Surveys have gone out to our community.

Discussion on how students in the Spanish program at BJPI may no longer be taking French in grades 4, 5 and 6. That extra time will be put into the Spanish Language Arts teaching hours.

More information to follow once the survey closes and data has been collated.

Staffing & Enrollment

 We are beginning to plan for the 2025–2026 school year. Projections look stable, and we are evaluating class configurations accordingly.

Looking Ahead

 Planning has started for year-end celebrations, Fun Day, Grade 6 farewell field trips, and grade transitions.

Budget for next year - support the same activities? Field Trips, Alien In-Line, Technology, August 28 Meet the Teacher Night

- *Rosanne confirmed with parent council what the \$2,000 for year end filed trips entail if some classrooms do not decide to use buses and leave the school. Parent Council confirmed that the \$2,000 was to be spit between kindergarten classes to grade 6. Approximately \$160 per classroom. If a classroom decides not to book a bus, it can be used towards another activity.
- *Student Fun Day will be discussed between Rosanne and Teresa and a day will be set. Looking at renting items and games from the City of Edmonton.
- *Grade 6B's will be attending Louis St. Laurent on May 6th. The students will be receiving their Spanish Bilingual Certificates for completing grade 6. Grades 9 and 12 will also be apart of the ceremony.
- *May 9th the grade 6 students will be attending Corpus Christi Parish for Carousel.
- *May 15th will be the grade 6 camp day at Camp Yowochas.
- *Grade 6 farewell will be June 24th. Chairs have been ordered.
- *Rosanne asked about a bill she has for \$12,700. Brandi explained how one detailed invoice needs to be provided to parent council WITH supporting invoices/receipts for all the items on the wish list and items school council agreed to pay for. One large cheque will be written to the school to cover all 2024/25 school year costs. \$12,700 invoice will be paid but more items need to be added and provided by the middle of June.
